3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To provide benefits in the form of skill development to unemployed youth belonging to the socially and economically weaker section of the society at free of cost or cost-to-cost.
2. To upskill individuals who have the willingness and determination to become self-sufficient and to serve others but lack resources and opportunities, including less privileged genders and children.
3. To encourage skilled and employed youth/individuals to guide, support and empower others for holistic growth, harmonious prosperity and inclusivity.
4. To establish, promote, support, and maintain schools, colleges, hostels, libraries, hospitals, reading rooms, lecture halls, museums and other establishments for useful knowledge.
5. To provide food, clothing and/or shelter to poor and needy persons and help them overcome struggles related to basic necessities of life.
6. To establish and maintain homes, orphanages, old-age homes, shelters and other relief establishments for

poor and destitute individuals, orphans and widows.

7. To undertake rehabilitation of orphaned children, impoverished mothers, impecunious fathers and other vulnerable persons to protect their wellbeing.

8. To help people affected by earthquakes, floods, fires, famines, pestilence and other natural calamities, and to work with institutions engaged in such relief work.

9. To support institutions working for the welfare of socially and economically backward classes, women, children and others.

10. To conduct educational programs in health care and provide assistance in primary health education.

11. To undertake any other act of medical relief, including the establishment of hospitals.

12. To establish, run and support schools, colleges, universities, madrasas, open schools, vocational institutes, coaching centres, research institutions, and hostels in India and abroad.

13. To promote Islamic education, modern education, vocational training, value-based education and skill development.

14. To operate digital universities, e-learning platforms, virtual classrooms and distance-learning systems.

15. To establish libraries, laboratories, innovation hubs, academic research centres and digital learning facilities.

16. To conduct teacher training programs, seminars, workshops, conferences and academic development programs.

17. To provide scholarships, books, uniforms, digital kits, study material and educational financial support.

18. To support special education for differently-abled, minority, orphaned and underprivileged students.

19. To collaborate with national and international universities, accreditation bodies and educational institutions.
20. To promote literacy, adult education, continuing education and girl-child education initiatives.
21. To promote social development, community upliftment, moral education and character building.
22. To conduct awareness programs on health, hygiene, sanitation, nutrition, environment, safety and social equality.
23. To run youth development programs, leadership training, personality development and sports development initiatives.
24. To promote women empowerment, livelihood creation, entrepreneurship and self-help group activities.
25. To run mental health awareness programs, counselling services, de-addiction support and social harmony initiatives.
26. To collaborate with government bodies, NGOs and institutions for social welfare programs.
27. To provide food, clothing, medicine and shelter to the poor, orphans, widows, elderly persons and vulnerable individuals.
28. To establish orphanages, old-age homes, rehabilitation centres, shelters and child protection institutions.
29. To conduct free medical camps, vaccination drives, mobile clinics and blood donation programs.
30. To distribute ration kits, medicines, educational materials and essential goods for welfare.
31. To support minority welfare, tribal welfare, rural development and slum development initiatives.

(b) \*Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To carry out relief operations during floods, earthquakes, pandemics and other emergencies.
2. To promote human rights, social justice, equality, dignity and constitutional freedoms.
3. To conduct awareness on child rights, women rights, disability rights and civil liberties.
4. To organize legal literacy camps, counselling centres and legal aid desks.
5. To support victims of exploitation, trafficking, abuse and injustice.
6. To collaborate with national and international human rights organizations.
7. To collaborate with international universities, NGOs, research bodies and global development agencies.
8. To conduct international training programs, exchange programs, conferences and research collaborations.
9. To establish overseas learning centres, global skill hubs and study centres.
10. To send volunteers, trainers, educators and students abroad for training and development.
11. To invite international experts, scholars and educators to India.
12. To work with embassies, UN bodies, foreign governments and international institutions.
13. To carry out educational, humanitarian and welfare projects in any part of the world.
14. To receive donations, grants, CSR funds and contributions from foreign individuals, NGOs, NRI donors, international agencies and global organizations.
15. To provide humanitarian aid and welfare support within India and abroad.
16. To run global

fundraising campaigns, donor networks and international charity programs.

17. To comply with FCRA laws and all applicable international funding regulations (when required).

18. To develop e-learning systems, digital universities, online Islamic education platforms and smart classrooms.

19. To create digital libraries, research portals, mobile apps and educational technology solutions.

20. To adopt Artificial Intelligence, AR/VR, cloud computing, robotics and technology innovations in education and welfare.

21. To promote digital literacy, IT skill development and technology-enabled learning programs.

22. To promote environmental conservation, afforestation, reforestation and pollution control activities.

23. To carry out climate action programs, water conservation, renewable energy promotion and sustainability campaigns.

24. To conduct environmental education and awareness programs.

25. To operate, implement, collaborate and execute all educational, social, humanitarian, developmental and welfare activities in any part of India and in any country of the world, without any geographical limitation.

26. To run, manage, promote and participate in all types of government and non-government programs for social development, free of cost or at cost-to-cost basis.

27. To employ any person, firm or company for carrying out any contract or work of the Company.

28. To pay expenses related to the promotion, formation and registration of the Company and to the modification of its Memorandum or Articles of Association, and other legal charges.

29. To enter into agreements with Indian or foreign governments, municipal bodies, local authorities or organizations beneficial to the Company's objects and to obtain rights, concessions or privileges.

30. To compensate directors or officers for loss of office within the limits prescribed by the Companies Act.

31. To institute, conduct, defend, settle or abandon legal proceedings by or against the Company and to allow time for payment or settlement of debts or claims.

32. To actively contribute towards achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by promoting inclusive growth, environmental sustainability, quality education, gender equality, good health and social equity, and to work as a catalyst for positive change by fostering community-driven initiatives, technological innovation and partnerships with government, industry, academia and civil society.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

9 True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
